- Long term goal is to install a Daily Mile track and outdoor fitness equipment which will be accessible to ALL children at White Bridge. If we are unable to build it with money from this year's allocation, then we will save some money and add it to next year's allocation.
- Continue membership of School Sports Partnership.
- Attending regular sport tournaments, festivals and competitions for all KS1 and KS2 children.
- Quality training for staff to raise their confidence and competence in teaching P.E. and sport.
- Providing supply cover to release teachers for professional development in P.E. and sport.
- Purchasing new equipment.
- Providing quality P.E. teaching through employing specialist sports coaches.
- Contribution towards the cost of transporting children to swimming so that they can achieve at levels beyond the statutory minimum.
