- ▣ To give all of our pupils the opportunity to participate in outdoor fitness and adventure activity every day.
- ▣ To embed the idea of regular exercise as an essential part of a healthy lifestyle

In 2018-2019 White Bridge Primary School will receive a grant of £19,660. We will spend this funding on the following projects, supplemented by our delegated budget and other funds to ensure that we support all of our pupils to ensure they continue to develop healthy, active lifestyles and increase their participation and enjoyment in PE and sport.
