

Year 1 –

This week the children have been learning about the story of 'We're Going on a Leaf Hunt'. We practised writing repetitive sentences as a way of re-telling the story. The children also described the events from the story.

In Maths we have continued subtraction number sentences using cubes to help us find the answer.

In Geography we learnt about the Arctic. We looked at some of the animals that live there, and wrote down some facts we had learnt.

Year 2 –

In Maths this week we have been measuring accurately in centimetres (cm) using a ruler. We have drawn different length lines and measured lines already drawn. We have also explored halving a given length in centimetres too.

As part of our English and significant people work we have been learning about Dame Kelly Holmes. We read lots of information about her and answered questions about what we had read. We then wrote different facts about her life so far and then made our own fact file page detailing her success.

In Science we have been continuing to learn about materials and their suitability for specific uses e.g. a wooden rabbit hutch is suitable but a fabric rabbit hutch is not.

In Computing we have practised using Google Classroom in the Computer Suite and will have another try next week so that we are confident using it. **Our log in sticker is on the inside front cover of our yellow reading diary.**

Homework

Reading is homework and the children should be reading to an adult at least 4/5 times a week, and reading diaries signed and dated. Please make sure that your child is doing this as it makes a considerable difference to their progress in reading, particularly if they talk and answer questions about what they have read.
