Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

This week we are revising money

- Find a collection of coins in your home.
- Identify 1p 2p 5p 10p 20p 50p £1 £2 coins

- Can you make a list of places from around the world using the alphabet?
E.g A- Africa B- Barcelona C- Chile

Weekly Writing Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Draw a picture of 10 different pieces of fruit or vegetables from around the world and label them using adjectives e.g. fresh, juicy pineapple.
- Choose a country from around the world whose food you particularly like. Maybe you like Italian food or Chinese food? What do you like about it? What flavours do you recognise? Make a list.
- Make a menu of food for a country choosing a starter, a main meal and a dessert.

- Can you add an adjective before each place that starts with the same letter?
E.g B- Beautiful Barcelona

Learning Project - to be done throughout the week: Around the world


- **Flags-** Look at [flags from around the world](#) which are your favourites and why? Can you make your favourite; this could be through drawing, collaging etc. Can you place the flag on a map? There are some quizzes that you can have a go at [here](#).
- **Dance Around the World-** Watch the following dances: [Diwali Stick Dance](#), [Maypole Dancing](#) and [Spanish Flamenco Dancing](#). Have a go at some of the moves used in these videos. Can you make up your own dance using some of those moves? How about dressing up using some items/clothes from your wardrobe and performing your dance to a family member? Record your dance if you can!
- **Food Tasting Fun-** Find some different fruits from around the world. This could include: mangos, kiwis, pineapples, bananas. Try them, which ones did you like and which ones did you not like? Cut the fruits open and draw the inside of each fruit. You could use pencils, coloured pencils or felt tip pens. Remember to look closely at the patterns and shapes.




